

THE FACULTY ASSOCIATION

All professional personnel of the college engaged in teaching are eligible, by virtue of employment, to become members in the Northeast Community College Faculty Association.

The organization and structure of the Faculty Association will be determined by a Faculty Association Constitution.

Annual dues for membership in the Faculty Association will be determined by the Faculty Association Constitution.

The Board of Governors of Northeast Community College recognizes the NCCFA as an independent local organization of the professional instructional staff.

The Faculty Association is affiliated with the NSEA (Nebraska State Education Association). Membership in NSEA is required in order to receive legal representation.

Faculty Executive Committee

1. The Executive Committee of the NCCFA is recognized by the Board of Governors of Northeast Community College as the governing body of the Faculty Association, with responsibilities as outlined in the NCCFA Constitution.
2. The Executive Committee of the Faculty Association shall consist of the officers of the association, the immediate past president, and one (1) appointed representative from each instructional division.
3. The officers of the Executive Committee, including the immediate past president, are the corresponding officers of the NCCFA, as outlined in the Faculty Association Constitution.
4. The Executive Committee conducts and supervises all elections and makes decisions concerning the affairs of the association. They establish standing committees and other committees as may be necessary to carry out the business of the association. Membership on the committees shall be appointed by the Faculty Association President with the advice and consent of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee receives reports directly from all appointed committee members. Decisions of the Executive Committee may be vetoed by a majority of the membership of the Faculty Association.
