Think E is for E Library – one of the library’s electronic databases - a favorite with students because it’s easy to use. eLibrary is a general research database providing full text and current information from thousands of sources. You can use eLibrary to find newspaper and magazine articles, but you can also find things like transcripts from radio and television programs and audio/video clips.

1. Access eLibrary by clicking on the “Library Services” link at the college home page <http://www.northeastcollege.com>
2. Click on the “Electronic Databases” tab and then scroll down the list to eLibrary.
3. For a quick and easy search, simply enter your search terms in the box at the top of the screen or try the advanced search options.
