

General Studies

The general studies associate of arts degree option recognizes those individuals who have completed various courses without a specific major or option in mind. In addition, the general studies concentration of 29 credit hours is designed for those students who want a broad-based grouping of courses either in career oriented or other academic areas without the constraints of specialization. Students who choose this degree option, will need a total of 60 credit hours: 31 credit hours in general education and, through advisement, 29 credit hours of approved vocational/occupational theory classes and/or other academic electives.
